July's Guest Speaker Chuck Purviance

Originally from Pittsburgh Pennsylvania, Chuck graduated from Edinboro University in December of 2013. He then became a resident artists at Brockway Center for Arts and Technology (BCAT) In Brockway, PA. As a resident, he helped maintained the studio, mentored teens in the after-school programs, taught community college and adult ed classes, and worked towards a solo show. In 2015 Purviance was asked to stay on at BCAT as the teaching artist and manage the day to day events of their ceramic department. Thanks to BCAT, he had the chance to host visiting artists in the ceramics field, managed resident artists, curated multiple ceramic shows at BCAT and across PA, and manage the day to day operations of a ceramics studio. Currently, Chuck is a first year MFA candidate at Wichita State University in Wichita, KS and is exploring new ideas, while working on and creating an evolving body of work.
